- o Meeting was called to order at approximately 1215 by Dana Murphy-Parker.
 - Management company transitions (Prime and C-Net) have been complete and IntNSA has been working with Prime Management Services for over 1 year, ANCB has been working with C-Net for over 1 year
 - A successful conference was held in Washington, DC in October of 2014 with 115 attendees (2015 conference in Charlotte expecting close to 190 participants. 2016 conference will be held in Las Vegas, Nevada.
