**International Scholarship to Attend the 2018 International Nurses
Society on Addictions (IntNSA) Conference in Denver, Colorado, USA**

The Foundation for Addictions Nursing (FAN) invites applications for a new International Scholarship! The scholarship will be awarded to one nursing student or one practicing nurse residing outside the US and US territories. Conference registration to the IntNSA conference, October 3-6, at the Embassy Suites Downtown, Denver, Colorado and a \$500 stipend towards expenses will be awarded to a nurse practicing in the field of addictions, or to one nursing student (undergraduate or graduate) interested in addictions nursing. Application Process

Applicants will submit a 250-500 word essay explaining their interest in attending the IntNSA conference and how the knowledge gained through conference attendance will benefit their (and/or others) education and/or practice. Identifying information will include Name, Credentials, Mailing Address, Email Address, Telephone Number, Employment (agency, position, role) or Educational Institution (school, program of study) and IntNSA membership status (if applicable).

Applicants will also submit a letter of recommendation from a supervisor, coworker, faculty member, IntNSA member, or other person who can attest to the applicant's interest and potential contributions in addictions nursing. If the applicant is a student, verification of student status by the college or university is required.

Identifying information, essay, letter of recommendation and verification of student status (if applicable) are due by July 15, 2018.
